




NOBLE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD
Tuesday, April 2, 2019 Meeting Agenda

As required by Title 25, Section 311 of the Oklahoma Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Noble County Election Board will hold a board meeting on Tuesday, April 2, 2019; at 6:30 p.m. Notice of the meeting was filed November 20, 2018 with the Noble County Clerk. The place and address of the meeting will be the Noble County Election Board office, first floor of the Noble County Courthouse, 300 Courthouse Drive No. 2, Perry, Oklahoma.

The following is a list of the business to be conducted by the Noble County Election Board at the above mentioned meeting. The order of the agenda items may be changed to accommodate the Board.

1. Call the meeting to order.
2. Roll Call.
3. Process mail absentee ballots, including opening the outer envelopes and examining the affidavits for sufficiency, removing the affidavit envelope, opening the secrecy envelope, and counting the ballots submitted for the April 2, 2019 Frontier, Billings, Ponca City, Garber and Glencoe School General Elections and City of Perry and Town of Billings Municipal Election.
4. Consideration, discussion and possible board action to approve the minutes for the meeting held February 15, 2019.
5. Approval of substitute Precinct Officials for the April 2, 2019 Canvass the April 2, 2019 Election returns for Frontier, Billings, Ponca City, Garber and Glencoe School General Elections and City of Perry and Town of Billings Municipal Election.
6. Appoint Precinct Officials as follows: Catherine Robinson as Inspector for precinct Marland 520104, Mary Koch as Inspector for precinct Sumner Baptist Church 520106, Pat Oller as Clerk for precinct Billings Community Bldg. 520103, JD Koch as Clerk for precinct 520106, Connie Henderson as Judge for precinct Perry Municipal Bldg. 520202, and Teresa Snyder as Judge in Precinct 1st Christen Church 520203.
7. Canvass the April 2, 2019 Municipal Election returns for The City of Perry and the Town of Billings. Canvass the General School Election returns for the Billings and Frontier Schools and the General Election returns for Garber, Glencoe & Ponca City Schools which are affected county schools.
